

A PREVIEW OF THE 2023 APPLICATION

If you'd like a look at the info you need before you start the process, here is what it will ask:

Section 1

Your information (name, email etc.)

Section 2

Tell us about your project!

Title:

Description for the Jury: Explain the Project in Full

Name you want listed publicly as the artist: (can be your real name or a playa/nick name):

Description for the Website: Explain the Project for the Flipizens.

Graphic: detailed drawings, CAD files/SketchUp documents, sketches, or other graphic illustrations of your creative concept. It can be stick figures if needed but something must be provided. The supplied graphic will appear on the ignition philter website

in the winners section. (You must have a Google account to do so.)

Will it need power (and if so, what is your power plan)?

Does the piece incorporate flame effects, moveable pieces, and/or is it climbable?

If it does incorporate flame effects, moveable pieces, and/or is climbable what is your safety plan?

[(Note: if flame effects are used, your project will be subject to inspection by the Burnable Art Lead, who has final say if your project will burn during the event).]

Section 3

Tell us about you!

*Tell us about your experience and history with projects on the scale of the one you are proposing. *Not having experience does not disqualify you from consideration, though for especially ambitious projects it helps to have a plan to learn new skills you will need.*

*Have you completed any other large scale art projects? (In this media? Where and when? How did the project go? Do you have pictures or recordings?) You may upload photos/recording of past projects here *You must have a Google account to do so.*

What is your timeline detailing the planning, creation, installment, and leave no trace removal of your project?

Section 4

Let's Talk Money!

How much money do you need? (Up to \$1000. Most grants will be to a max of \$575, but 3 projects may get up to \$1000)

Have you received funding from any other entity or regional for this piece previously? If so, who and how much? (Having received past funding will not disqualify you if you are using the funds to add to the piece.)

Upload a spreadsheet of your budget here.: We are looking for a thorough itemized budget and the amount of grant money you are requesting. Please include a reasonably researched estimate of the cost of the materials you expect to need.

Save and provide receipts of materials greater than or equal to grant amount by 07/01/22. -If you do not provide this information you be disqualified from receiving a grant in the future.

If for some reason the piece is not shown at Flipside 2023, the funds will be returned to Ignition Philter by 07/01/23
